ARRIVAL: Please arrive no earlier than 6 a.m.

TURN IN:

Ribs: 2:00 p.m.

COOKS MEETING will be at 8:30 a.m.

- Contest rules and scoring will be based on KCBS.
- Contestants must cook in both categories to qualify for the overall prize.
- Competitors are required to use their own smokers, secret rubs, spices, and injections and all cooking **must be done** at Schell's Brewery.
- Participants must provide all equipment used for preparation and cooking.
- Power will be provided but you will need to bring your own extension cords to get to the source. Bring extra just in case.
- Per KCBS rules, *(fires shall be of wood, wood pellets or charcoal. Gas and electric heat sources shall NOT be permitted for cooking or holding. Propane or electric is permitted as fire starters, provided that the competition meat is not in/on the cooking device. Electrical accessories such as spits, augers, or forced draft are permitted. No open pits or holes are permitted, except at the election of the contest organizer. Fires shall not be built on the ground.)*
- You are encouraged to use garnish in the turn in box.
- TEAMS WILL OBSERVE ALL FOOD AND HEALTH SANITATION REQUIREMENTS
